

# Summit Workshops 2010

## Session I Workshops 10:15-11:05 am

### 1. "A Man and His Woman", Dan Jarrell, Room: Denali

Discover God's purpose, plan, and power given to make your marriage all that he created it to be. You will learn practical concepts to love your wife and to cultivate her as a valuable partner in your life.

### 2. "Restoring and Strengthening Relationships through Biblical Repentance and Forgiveness", James Keen, Room: Resurrection Bay

In the 18<sup>th</sup> chapter of Matthew, Christ promised that offences would abound. They can be found in relationships with co-workers, neighbors, fellow church members, families, and even with our wife. Sin breaks down relationships but biblical repentance and forgiveness will make them even stronger than before. Come learn about the biblical model for forgiveness and how these principles can be applied to every relationship in your life.

### 3. "The Weight of your Sin Lifted: Enjoying a Clean Conscience Again", Jeff Crotts, Room: Ketchikan Hanger

Psalm 32 is a song of penance and deliverance. Its lyrics sung by the Nation of Israel, flow from King David's heart- a man who suffered (inside and out) under the extreme weight of guilt from the extreme sins he committed. When we think of King David's sin, what probably comes to mind is David's adultery with Bathsheba. Taking a closer look at what happened, reveals a man who stair-stepped in a downward spiral of sin choices which seemed to leave him hopeless. I want us to unpack Psalm 32 not only for its beauty but for its grace. David's testimony offers real hope and instruction for men struggling with a guilty conscience. Studying this passage will also equip you to help others in need of a pathway back to the joy of forgiveness.

### 1. "Sexual Integrity: Prepare Yourself for Battle", Mark Meredith, Room: Denali
